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Please be advised that the San Bernardino County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and approved a Report of Facility Information (RFI) Amendment for Big Bear Transfer station (SWIS# 36-AA-0417). The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the San Bernardino County, including all active transfer stations.

### Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

Big Bear Transfer Station (BBTS) is located at 38550 Holcomb Valley Road, Big Bear, California 92314. On April 17, 2026, the LEA received an RFI Amendment Application Package to address the "Findings" identified during the facility's Five-Year Permit Review.

The changes include the following:

- Revisions to ensure consistency throughout the TPR, including updates to figures and tables to accurately reflect the current permit.
- The incorporation of written procedure required under SB 1383, including protocols for the handling and storage of organic waste and waste characterizations.

The LEA finds that the proposed changes are consistent with all applicable certified and/or adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA accepted the RFI Amendment on May 15, 2026.
