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Please be advised that San Bernardino County Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to the Transfer Processing Report (TPR) for the Yucca Valley Transfer Station. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within San Bernardino County, including all active transfer stations.

### Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

Yucca Valley Transfer Station is located at the southeast corner of Sunnyslope Drive and Indio Avenue. On March 30, 2026, the LEA received, from Yucca Valley Transfer Station, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend their TPR in the form of an RFI amendment.

The changes include the following:

- Updates for consistency throughout the TPR to reflect the current permit
- The addition of written procedures for SB 1383.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable certified and/pr adopted CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA accepted the amendment on April 29, 2026.
