## COMMERCIAL EDIBLE FOOD GENERATOR (CEFG) FOOD RECOVERY PRE-EVENT SURVEY

Senate Bill (SB) 1383 requires Commercial Edible Food Generators (CEFGs), such as large venues and events, to have a plan in place for any excess edible food that may be available at the end of the event. CEFGs must plan for food recovery logistics and establish written agreements with Food Recovery Organizations (FROs) in advance. CEFGs must also maintain donation records when donating recovered food to FROs. Use this Pre-Event Survey as record keeping for your food recovery program.
