

AB 1276 Single-Use Foodware & Condiments



Effective Jan. 1, 2022, AB 1276, a state mandate will prohibit food facilities from providing any single-use foodware accessory or standard condiment to a consumer unless requested. The bill will authorize a food facility to ask a drive-through consumer if the consumer wants a single-use foodware accessory in specified circumstances.

Service Requirements



Dine-in

Only provide single-use accessories to consumers upon request or self-serve stations.



Third-party Delivery

Third-party delivery platforms shall provide consumers with single-use accessories and condiments, and food service providers must customize menu with a list of available single-use accessories or condiments. Only those items chosen by the consumer will be delivered.



Take-out

Only provide single-use accessories to consumers upon request or offer.



Drive-thru

Only provide single-use accessories if they are necessary to consume prepared food.
