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The San Bernardino County Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Services, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), will conduct a public information meeting for any interested parties to learn more about the new proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the **Yucca Valley Transfer Station SWIS No. 36-AA-0494**. **Due to current COVID-19 concerns the meeting will be held virtually via Zoom.** Interested parties may provide comments to the LEA regarding the proposed actions. The LEA is certified by the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all disposal site facilities. All comments will be considered when the LEA makes a determination to process the proposed permit. CalRecycle will act on the LEA's recommendation for the proposed SWFP within the next 90 days.

## Description of Project:

The Yucca Valley Transfer Station, Facility No. 36-AA-0494, is located in San Bernardino County in the high desert region in the Town of Yucca Valley. The Yucca Valley Transfer Station is a large volume transfer/processing facility designed to accept municipal solid waste, source separated green waste, and construction demolition debris materials generated within the high desert area of Yucca Valley, Joshua Tree, Landers, and Morongo Valley. The design of the transfer station will allow for the dumping and loading of incoming loads of waste and recyclable materials into 120 cubic yard walking floor transfer trailers within a fully enclosed structure. The transfer station has been designed to efficiently transfer residential wastes to permitted sanitary landfill. The 10-acre waste management facility is located on a 30-acre parcel owned by Desert Properties, a subsidiary of Burrtec Waste Industries, Inc (BWI). The new proposed SWFP will allow the facility to accept up to 500 tons and up to 177 vehicles per day. The facility has a total storage capacity of 793 tons. An application for a SWFP was received by the LEA from BWI on November 4, 2020.

**LEA's Preliminary Determination:**

The SWFP application was accepted as complete and correct and filed on December 4, 2020. A proposed permit will be sent to the CalRecycle requesting concurrence and subsequent LEA issuance.

**Purpose of the Meeting:**

This public informational meeting is for any interested parties to learn more about the new proposed SWFP and to provide comments for consideration to the LEA regarding the proposed action. Prior to issuance of the SWFP, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from CalRecycle.
