Please be advised that the County of San Bernardino, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received and accepted a Report of Facility Information (RFI) amendment to Joint Technical Document (JTD) for the USMC Twentynine Palms Disposal Facility. The LEA is certified by the California Department of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active and closed landfills.

Description of Project and LEA's Preliminary Determination

USMC Twentynine Palms Disposal Facility is located at the Marine Air Ground Task Force Training Command/Marine Corps Air Ground Combat Center at Landfill Road in Twentynine Palms, CA 92278. On August 14, 2020 the LEA received, a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package to amend the JTD.

The changes include the following:

- Updates to the operational changes related to the collection and disposal of the wood and green waste material, and
- Updates to the description of processed wood waste.

The LEA finds that the proposed change is consistent with all applicable CEQA documents, is consistent with State Minimum Standards, and does not conflict with the terms and conditions in the current solid waste facilities permit. The LEA accepted the amendment on September 9, 2020
