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### Purpose of the Meeting

As a property owner, tenant, or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the San Bernardino County, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Services – Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a joint meeting with the Applicant of City of Claremont Community Services Department (Facility), Solid Waste Information System (SWIS) # 36-AA-0425, to the public or interested parties regarding the proposed upgrade to the transfer/processing activities at the Facility. Please be further advised that this notice is not for a public hearing. The joint meeting is for an informational meeting by the LEA to provide information pursuant to California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 27 Section 21660.2 and a public meeting by the Applicant to address public comments pursuant to 27 CCR § 21570(g). The informational meeting is also used to incorporate comments from the public or interested parties for the purposes of consideration when drafting the proposed Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) for the Facility. The comments may also be used in consideration of the Facility. The LEA will make a determination regarding the proposed SWFP and must be made by the LEA after 60 days of this public information meeting. Prior to issuance of the SWFP, the LEA must request and receive concurrence from CalRecycle.

The LEA is certified by CalRecycle, to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County of San Bernardino, including all active transfer stations.

### Description of Project

The Facility is located at 1616 Monte Vista Avenue, Claremont, CA 91711. On February 14, 2023, the LEA received from the Applicant, the official submittal of an application for a Large Volume Transfer/Processing Facility (LVTPF) in a CalRecycle E-1-77 Form (rev. 11/15). This Facility is an already existing Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility that is upgrading from a Registration Permit receiving 99.9 tons per day of municipal solid waste (MSW), green material, recyclables, and other permitted material from the City of Claremont residents to a Full SWFP permitted to receive and process 184 tons per day.

Activities at the Facility will include unloading of vehicles, moving, sorting, processing, load checking, loading of transfer vehicles and transporting solid waste and recyclables from the Facility for final disposition to a landfill or further end-use.

The proposed permit will make the following changes in design and operation:

- Upgrade to a Large Volume Transfer/Processing Facility (LVTPF) from a Medium volume Transfer Processing Facility;
- Upgrade permitted materials receipt limits from 99.9 tons of municipal solid waste (MSW), green material, recyclables, and other permitted material from the City of Claremont residents to 184 tons;
- Upgrade permitted daily vehicle traffic from 29 vehicles per day to 44 vehicles per day;
- Operating acreage will remain the same – 4.82 acres;
- Operate during the following hours:
  - Receipt & Processing of Material: Monday – Saturday 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM
  - Transfer of Material Off-Site – Monday – Saturday 6:00 AM to 5:00 PM
  - Maintenance/Motor Fleet: Monday – Friday 6:30 AM to 4:30 PM
  - Administrative/Ancillary: Monday – Thursday 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM

### Findings

The LEA finds that the proposed SWFP is consistent with and is supported by the environmental documents cited above, and information contained in the Facility's Report of Composting Site Information.

The LEA proposes to issue a SWFP to upgrade the Facility from a Medium Volume Transfer/Processing Facility to a Large Volume Transfer/Processing Facility.
