As an owner, tenant or person who has requested notice, please be advised that the San Bernardino County Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding an informational public hearing in compliance with Public Resources Code Section 44004 for the purposes of consideration of a proposed new Solid Waste Facility Permit for the Freepoint Eco-Systems Yermo Supply LLC Plastics Sorting and Processing Facility. The LEA is certified by CalRecycle to enforce state laws and regulations at solid waste sites within the County, including all transfer/processing facilities.

Purpose of the Meeting

Please be advised that the San Bernardino County, Department of Public Health, Division of Environmental Health Services Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) will be holding a joint meeting with the Applicant of Freepoint Eco-Systems Yermo Supply LLC Plastics Sorting and Processing Facility, Solid Waste Information System (SWIS) #36-AA-0514, for the public or interested parties regarding a new Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP). This is an informational meeting by the LEA to provide information pursuant to California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 27 Section 21660.2 and a public meeting by the Applicant to address public comments pursuant to 27 CCR § 21570(g).

Description of Project

The Freepoint Eco-Systems Yermo Supply LLC Plastics Sorting and Processing Facility, SWIS No. 36-AA-0514 will be located south of Yermo Road, east of Dusty Trail, and north of the Union Pacific Railroad tracks in the unincorporated town of Yermo, San Bernardino County, California. On January 20, 2026, the LEA accepted for review a Solid Waste Facility Permit (SWFP) application package from the Freepoint Eco-Systems Yermo Supply LLC Plastics Sorting and Processing Facility requesting a new permit for a new large volume transfer/processing facility. The project would process post-industrial waste that is almost 100 percent usable plastic feedstock, and sort post-consumer materials received from Material Recovery Facilities (MRFs) that are anticipated to have at least 85 percent usable feedstock. Plastic materials received from MRFs may be bales of products like film plastics, rigid plastics, high-density polyethylene, or polypropylene. Other postconsumer materials that may be received from MRFs include residue bales, which may be composed of 50 percent to 70 percent usable plastic feedstock and other recyclable materials. The processed plastics would then be shipped to an Arizona facility. Other recyclable materials such as old, corrugated containers, ferrous metals, and non-ferrous metals would be collected by traditional mechanical third-party recyclers. Any residual or unusable material would be trucked off-site for disposal at a landfill, such as the Barstow Landfill located to the west of the Facility. Other landfills that may be used for disposal of residuals include the Landers Sanitary Landfill, San Timoteo Sanitary Landfill, Mid-Valley Sanitary Landfill and Victorville Sanitary Landfill.

Key Details

The proposed new permit is to allow the design and operations of a new facility as follows:

- Operate a large volume transfer/processing facility within a completely enclosed building.
- Receive up to 855 tons maximum daily.
- Allow 147 vehicles per day.
- Operate the following hours: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week including holidays. Facility Accepts incoming tonnage Monday through Saturday.

State law requires compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act either through the preparation, circulation and adoption/certification of an environmental document and mitigation reporting or monitoring program or by determining that the proposal is categorically or statutorily

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exempt. The San Bernardino County, Land Use Services Department, acting as the Lead Agency, had prepared the following environmental document for Freepoint Eco-Systems Yermo Supply LLC located at 37265 Yermo Road, Yermo, San Bernardino County, CA.

- A Draft Initial Study/ Mitigated Negative Declaration. State Clearinghouse No. 2025100156 with a public review period of 30-days from 10/03/2025-11/03/2025. The Initial Study/ Mitigated Negative Declaration was certified by San Bernardino County, Planning Commission on 11/20/2025. San Bernardino County Land Use Services Department issued a Conditional Use Permit authorizing and conditioning the project.

The documents above support the limits of the proposed permit for the Freepoint Eco-Systems Yermo Supply LLC.

- Operating Hours: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week including holidays.
- Permitted Tons Per Operating Day: 855 tons maximum daily.
